Our Children's Code of Conduct

How We Play, Learn, and Care Together

Welcome to our service! This is a place to have fun, make friends, and feel safe. To help everyone enjoy their time here, we follow these simple and kind rules:

1. Treat Others How You Would Like to Be Treated
 - Be kind, respectful, and considerate.
 - Treat others the way you would like to be treated.
2. Your Actions Shouldn't Make Others Feel Unsafe or Hurt Others
 - Always be kind and respectful.
 - Your actions should never make other children or educators, or visitors feel unsafe, worried, upset or hurt.
3. Keep Your Hands and Feet to Yourself
 - No hitting, kicking, biting, or touching others.
 - Respect everyone's personal space.
4. Use Object Safely
 - Do not use toys, books, or any items to hit or hurt others.
 - Everything we use is for learning and fun — not for fighting.
5. Respect Others' Belongings
 - Do not go into other children's bags or touch their things without permission.
 - We keep our hands to ourselves and respect others' items.
6. No Recording Others
 - Do not take picture or videos of children or educators with a personal device.
 - Do not take pictures or videos of other children using a Camp Australia device.
 - Respect everyone's privacy and personal space.
7. No Bullying or Racist Comments
 - Treat everyone with kindness, fairness, and respect.
 - Bullying or mean words about someone's skin colour or where they come from is not allowed. We celebrate everyone's differences!

8. Use Kind Words

- Speak nicely to everyone.
- No name-calling, teasing, or yelling.

9. Be Responsible

- Make sure you can see an educator at all times
- Let an educator know if you need help

Remember:

OSHC is a place where everyone belongs, everyone matters, and everyone deserves to have fun. Let's work together to make it awesome for all!

If this code of conduct is not followed, there may be consequences like taking a break from coming to our Camp Australia service or not being allowed to come back.
